

Mixing and feeding directions:

Add 0.25 pounds HerdFirst® Enhancer to low solids whole milk that total 4 or more quarts of whole milk per calf per day. Split this amount evenly between the number of feedings per calf per day. Consult with your nutritionist to establish minimum and maximum total solids and % solids fed. Fresh, clean water must be available continuously. Do not feed more than 0.25 pounds of HerdFirst® Enhancer per calf per day.


Hand feed at a rate of 1 mg of lasalocid per 2.2 lb of body weight per day.

Thoroughly mix this milk replacer powder with warm water and feed immediately. When preparing large batches (i.e., anything other than individual calf servings) keep the mixture agitated while dispensing into individual feeding containers to prevent settling. One-quarter pound of Milk Enhancer powder daily will medicate 150 lbs. of body weight.


What does the nutritional content of whole milk look like?

Whole milk can be deficient in several vitamins and trace minerals. The list of deficiencies includes manganese, copper, iron, cobalt, iodine, and vitamin E. Selenium can also be quite variable within whole milk. This is why including a HerdFirst® whole milk additive is important to help support the growth goals of your young animal nutrition program.
